Information Assurance Engineer

This position will be located at the White Sands Missile Range in New Mexico and requires a Secret/SSBI or Top Secret clearance.

Responsibilities:

- Provides Tier 2 assistance for personnel / users needing information/assistance with Information Assurance (IA) and CSMO related issues.
- Risk Management/Accreditation/Certification Services; Assist the Information Systems Security Manager (ISSM) in the management of the RMF process in accordance with AR 25-2 and DoD 8510.01. Provide Knowledge Management Services for all information required to perform Certification and Accreditation services for the White Sands Missile Range Cyber Security Management Office (CSMO).
- Position requires knowledge of SharePoint services in maintaining required documentation such as appointment orders, Authority to Connect (ATC) and Authority to Operate (ATO) documentation, library of Army and other regulations relating to Information Assurance, Memorandums of Understanding/Agreement, Tenant Security Plans, Certificates of Networkiness (CoNs), etc.
- Directly supports Information Assurance (IA) requirements, within the immediate area of responsibility (AOR), managing and tracking system administrator elevated level of access to network resources. Therefore, requires the knowledge of the Army Training and Certification Tracking System (ATCTS), and IA DoD 8570.01 status verification.
- Works with team members to identify IA trends and suggests long-term strategies to help mitigate IA issues.
- Analyzes and evaluates risk and makes recommendations that are in compliance with all policies, rules and regulations governing IA functions.
- Assesses procedures and identifies opportunities to improve customer service.
- Coaches, develops and inspires staff to maximize their potential.

.Education/Experience - B.S. degree in Information Technology or related field and five to seven years of experience in the specialized field of Information Assurance. Also requires demonstrated experience of various COTS software/hardware, and network products; Windows OS, MS Office, Remedy, etc. Relevant and equivalent experience may be substituted for degree requirement.

Skills/Certifications/Training – Security+ CE certification, and relevant Computing Environment training, in accordance with DoD 8570.01m. Good oral and written communication skills. Ability to react to customer issues and formulate resolutions quickly.
