## Program Manager

### Responsibilities:

Manage multiple projects at diverse locations. Organize, direct, and coordinate planning and production of all contractor contract support activities. Formulate and review strategic plans and deliverable items, determine contract costs and ensure conformance with standards. Interpret and explain policies, purpose and goals of the contractor organization to subordinates. Must be authorized to negotiate and make binding decisions for the company. Specific responsibilities and approaches are detailed in the contractor's Quality Assurance Plan. Actively ensure implementation of and compliance with the Quality Assurance Plan. Possess high-level oral and written communications skills; effectively communicate with all levels of client management, contractor managers and client agency representatives; adept in generating and conducting briefings, presentations, etc.

Specialized - Five (5) years within the last ten (10) calendar years of experience supervising and managing substantive IT projects involving software development or computer operations projects. Specifically, two (2) years within the last five (5) calendar years of intensive and current, industry accepted experience managing complex software projects, including the management of at least 50 or more IT specialists, in subordinate groups and in diverse locations or large, complex computer operations projects including the management of at least 30 personnel in subordinate groups working in multiple locations. The Program Manager must demonstrate one (1) year's intensive and current, industry accepted experience managing complex organizations for which they had total responsibility for the financial success of the organization.
