Responsibilities:

Provide expert-level VDI trouble-shooting and service deliverables. Lead and oversee highly complex VDI projects. Direct and contribute to multi-faceted VMware vSphere enterprise configuration initiatives. Oversee installation, configuration, and management of VMware vSphere, to include deployment of ESXi hosts and vCenter Servers, management of ESXi host, storage, networking, and virtual machines via vCenter Server. Monitor and optimize the performance of VMware vSphere components. Perform capacity planning and trend analysis of VMware ESXi hosts for CPU and Memory. Establish, build, maintain, and deploy ECR Master Image/Recompose to VDI training sites. Develop and document a standard testing and troubleshooting methodology in order to debug operational faults and identify root causes. Design methodologies to include best practices and recommendations based on gathered/analyzed data, and make sound design decisions for client systems, desktop options, vSphere infrastructure, and View components. Develop instructions to support installations and integration of operating system software, and modify/maintain integration packages via releases and utilities from manufacturers in a multi-operating system and/or network operating system environment. Develop standard operating procedures of documented step-by-step instructions to complete required tasks performed by the team. Utilize sound change/configuration management discipline for supporting new requirements and sustainment changes. Provide routine reports and performance metrics to the ECR Program Management Office to include host, client, and workforce utilization, POD component performance and trends for exceeded thresholds. Possess high-level oral and written communications skills; effectively communicate with all levels of client management, contractor managers and client agency representatives; adept in generating and conducting briefings, presentations.
