## Information Assurance Engineer

This position will be located at the White Sands Missile Range in New Mexico and requires a Secret/SSBI or Top Secret clearance. This is a supervisory position, and applicant will lead and direct the work of approximately 4 CSMO support personnel.

### Responsibilities:

- Serve as the Lead managing all activities related to the Cyber Security Management Office (Scan Team and Documentation Areas), including personnel scheduling, and performance improvement plans and reviews.
- Evaluate and anticipate work volume; assign and distribute work among staff accordingly.
- Provide Tier 2 assistance for personnel / users needing information/assistance with Information Assurance (IA) and CSMO related issues.
- Assist the Information Systems Security Manager (ISSM) in the management of the RMF process in accordance with AR 25-2 and DoDI 8510.01. Risk Management/Accreditation/Certification Services
- Provide Knowledge Management Services for all information required to perform Certification and Accreditation services for the White Sands Missile Range Cyber Security Management Office (CSMO).
- Directly support Information Assurance (IA) requirements, within the immediate area of responsibility (AOR), manage and track system administrator elevated level of access to network resources.
- Work with team members to identify IA trends and suggests long-term strategies to help mitigate IA issues.
- Analyze and evaluate risks and make recommendations that are in compliance with all policies, rules and regulations governing IA functions.

### Qualifications:

#### Secret/SSBI or Top Secret Clearance

- B.S. degree in IT or related field and 5-7 years of experience in the specialized field of Information Assurance.
- Demonstrated experience of various COTS software/hardware, and network products; Windows OS, MS Office, Remedy, etc. Relevant and equivalent experience may be substituted for degree requirement.
- Security+ CE certification, and relevant Computing Environment training (DoD 8570.01m).

### Required Skills:

- Knowledge of SharePoint services and ability to maintain required documentation including appointment orders, ATC and ATO documentation, library of Army and other regulations relating to Information Assurance, Memorandums of Understanding/Agreement, Tenant Security Plans, Certificates of Networkiness (CoNs), etc.
- Knowledge of the Army Training and Certification Tracking System (ATCTS), and IA DoD 8570.01 status verification
- Good oral and written communication skills. Ability to react to customer issues and formulate resolutions quickly.
