

The Seaport NxG Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract by Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) has a \$21 Billion program ceiling with a five (5)-year base period and a five (5)-year option period. All task orders fall under North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code 541330, with a revenue size standard of \$38.5 Million.
